#### This funding will be used to

Ensure student improvement in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.

#### Reading

- 96% of Years 3 and 5 students achieve National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN Reading.
- 50% of Years 3 students and 40% of Year 5 students achieve U2B in NAPLAN Reading.
- 100% of students with an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP) meet reading benchmarks that are set.
- 75% of Prep Year 1 and 65% of Year 2 6 Students achieve School defined reading benchmarks.

#### **Writing**

- 96% of Years 3 and 5 students achieve NMS in NAPLAN Writing.
- 45% of Years 3 Students and 40% of Year 5 students achieve U2B in NAPLAN Writing.
- 100% of students with an ICP for English achieve a C or higher.
- 95% of students across the school achieve a C or higher in English in Semester 2.

#### **Numeracy**

- 96% of Years 3 and 5 students achieve NMS in NAPLAN Numeracy.
- 45% of Years 3 students and 40% of Year 5 students achieve Upper Two Band (U2B) in NAPLAN Numeracy.
- 100% of students with an ICP for Mathematics achieve a C or higher.
- 95% of students across the school achieve a C or higher in Mathematics in Semester 2.

#### Our initiatives include

- Improving teacher capability through the refinement of the school coaching and feedback model.
- Providing additional staffing allocation of a fulltime pedagogy coach to build capacity in staff to teach LEM Phonics and Writing.
- Providing additional staffing allocation of a U2B teacher to support students and teachers in extending our top students in Reading, Writing and Numeracy in Year 2, 4 and 6.
- Facilitating extension groups for Reading, Writing, and Numeracy from Years 2 6, backed up by support for teachers to improve outcomes for students not in extension groups.
- Providing additional Teacher Aide time in key year levels to support targeted and differentiated teaching.
- Providing additional Teacher Aide time dedicated to support our students that require the most support in the Junior School in reading.
- Providing additional time allocated to teachers each week for student feedback and watching other teachers on top of their NCT allocation.
- Providing support teachers with extra Teachers and Teacher Aides, for the implementation of reading groups.
