
## Our initiatives include

- Improve teacher Capability through the refinement of the school coaching and feedback model.
- Additional staffing allocation to ensure STEM, Extension, and Learning support opportunities are available to students.
- Additional Teacher Aide time in all year levels to support targeted and differentiated teaching.
- Additional Teacher Aide time dedicated to support our students that require the most support in the Junior School.
- Additional time allocated to teachers each week for student feedback and watching other teachers on top of their NCT allocation.
- Teachers that are applying for HAT/Lead Teacher status leading improvement initiatives in the school. These teachers are given the time to support other teachers also.

Actions	Costs
Investing in teacher aide time to support all classes in meeting the individual needs of students in each class with the focus on getting the students achieving less than a C in 2021 over the line in 2022. This funding also supports full time Aide allocations in all Prep classes to support a successful transition to school.	\$ 166,000.00
Investing extra support teacher time to help meet the needs of the students in diverse classrooms. These teachers are to ensure that all students receive the differentiated support required to achieve.	\$ 36,987.00
